Terms and Conditions

- The VPHA understands that where the stallion will be live covering the mare, the service fee as stated on this form includes any handling or booking fees. This will be the service fee that is advertised for the said stallion. There will be no further charges to the purchaser other than: Agistment, Vet fees and collection fees (if applicable) as per the stallion owner's original contract. These fees will be discussed between the purchaser and the owner of the stallion and they will come to an arrangement without any further input from the VPHA.
- In the instance that semen (cooled or frozen) is to be collected and shipped, this will all be done at the full expense of the mare owner. The mare owner will need to liaise directly with the stallion owner with regard to these additional costs.
- A copy of the stallion owner's contract will be forwarded to the VPHA and may be made available for perusal of any potential purchaser of the service.
- Mare Owners will be made aware that the mare must be in good breeding condition prior to service. The stallion owner will have the right of refusal for any mare that is not in healthy condition.
- The stallion owner has the right to demand a vet check or swab on any mare prior to her being bred. This will be carried out at the mare owner's expense.

- Your nominated stallion will be advertised on the VPHA Website's Stallion Directory. The VPHA website is at www.vpha.com.au
- There will be a separate link on the website for the Stallion Sale which will showcase all of the nominated stallions. Please forward any advertising material to the Stallion Co-ordinator Sue Sparkman at E-Mail susansparkman@hotmail.com Your Stud will also be listed on the website's 'Sponsors Page' and 'Stud Link'.
- The VPHA Stallion Service Sale may be advertised in the PHAA Journal, Horse Deals and other publications as deemed appropriate by the VPHA.

VPHA Stallion Sale Weanling & Yearling Futurity

- All of the nominated stallion's progeny born in 2009, will be eligible to enter the VPHA stallion service futurities;
- The **VPHA Stallion Sale Weanling and Yearling Futurities** will be held annually at the **VPHA Open Western Breeds Multi Judge pre State Show** (the day prior to the Victorian Paint State Show). This allows all Western breeds to compete in these futurities.
- Only the progeny of donated stallions are allowed to compete in these futurities.
- For Stallion Services that are donated in 2008, all of the Stallions progeny will be eligible for the following classes;
 - VPHA Stallion Sale Weanling & Yearling Futurity 2009 (only)**
 - VPHA Stallion Sale Weanling Futurity – 2010 (only)**
 - VPHA Stallion Sale Yearling Futurity – 2011 (only)**
- The **owners** of donated stallions are entitled to a free entry fee into each of the futurities, for any progeny that are bred by and registered in the stallion owner's name.
